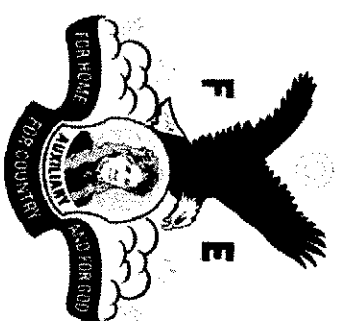

Hospitality Room Policies

A \$100 Deposit will be required for all necessary extra clean up and will be returned if not used. Must be a separate check!

DEPOSIT MUST BE PAID BEFORE ARRIVAL.

*We understand that you will provide your own food and beverage.

*Hotel guest rooms that are being used as hospitality rooms will have all furniture, including televisions, removed prior to your arrival.

*Our banquet department will provide a limited number of tables, chairs, wastebaskets and disposable table coverings for each hospitality room.

*Hospitality rooms will be cleaned each morning starting at 8:00am. You **MUST** have a representative of your hospitality room in the room during cleaning.

*We do not allow signs to be hung on brick walls, glass windows, ceilings, finished walls or doorways of the hotel.

*Due to safety rules, we do not allow grilling (gas, electric, or charcoal) within 50 feet of the hotel. No open flames are allowed in the hospitality rooms.

*No dumping coolers from anywhere on the second floor. You must go down to ground level to dump all coolers.

***NO SMOKING OF ANY KIND ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE HOTEL-INCLUDING HOSPITALITY ROOMS.**

*Each hospitality room will have electrical power available. Please limit the number of electrical appliances you use. This will help insure that all hospitality rooms have enough power. Please bring your own extension cords.

*you will be responsible for locking and unlocking the room during convention.

You are responsible for keeping the hospitality room in the same condition that it is when you arrive. Please put plastics under ice coolers or anything that may soil the carpet. Best Western Valley Plaza Inn reserves the right to be compensated for the fair value of damages to the hospitality room.

The 117th Annual Convention of the Michigan State Aerie will be a Joint Convention with the State Auxiliary. It will be held in Midland, Michigan at the Valley Plaza Resort of Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, June 9th, 10th, and 11th, 2022

Delegates

The State Aerie By-laws provide that the Aeries have one vote for each one hundred (100) members or major fraction thereof, based on the number of members subject to the Per Capita, as shown on the June 1st 2021 Annual Report, and on which the Per Capita tax has been paid. This does not mean that your Aerie has to send a delegate for each vote, as there is no limit of the number of votes that one Delegate can carry. It is entirely up to your Aerie how many Delegates are sent. Any Past President, or Ten Year Secretary who is not a delegate but wishes to use his vote, may do so upon payment of the registration fee. No delegate will be seated, nor will any Ritual Unit be eligible to enter competition, unless their Aerie has paid their Per capita tax through June 1 2021.

PLEASE NOTE any member not attending the Convention as a registered Delegate, Past President, or Ten Year Secretary must register as a Member at the cost of \$35.00 to participate in any Hospitality Rooms per Michigan State Aerie.

Credential List and Registration Fee

There will be a registration fee of \$35.00 per Delegate, which each Aerie will allow its accredited Delegates above any other expenses. You will find enclosed in this bulletin a copy of the Credential List to be filled out and returned to me with your Registration fee of \$35.00 per Delegates and non Delegates **April 15th 2022**. Please be sure to list ALL of your Delegates, non-delegate members, Past Worthy Presidents, Ten Year Secretaries, and any Past State Presidents, and currently serving State Officers. All Persons listed must be in good standing in your Aerie. Indicate the number of votes each Delegate is entitled to cast. The Total Aerie vote is to be entered at the top of the form. If each Aerie Secretary will do this, each delegate and non-delegate member will be pre-registered and will only have to show his Official Receipt and sign for his envelope, which will contain his Badge and Credential Book.

Hall of Fame

Perhaps now is the time you should look around your Aerie and see if you have a member of your Aerie that you think should be elected to the Hall of Fame. The rules are as follows:

Management:

The Committee to select nominees shall consist of all Past State Presidents.

Membership:

The following requisites are essential for all nominees to the Michigan Hall of Fame:

Deceased nominee, no limit as to number of years of membership.

Living nominee must have 20 years of continuous membership.

Nominee must be in good standing at his Local Aerie.

Applications

Applications can be made from an Aerie on behalf of any nominee so qualified, but must be made in writing to the Michigan Hall of Fame Committee by May 2nd, 2022. Also must have signatures of the Worthy President, and Secretary with the Aerie Seal affixed.

No more than one application per year from each Aerie for each category.

Selection by the Past State Presidents will be made by mail, with copies of all applications that are qualified. They will select a maximum of five (5) nominees per year and no more than three (3) deceased.

If your application is not selected, it will be good for one more year, then a new application must be filed. After two years the previous applications will be destroyed.

STATE REAC LUNCHEON

The annual REAC Banquet will be held on Wednesday June 8th. Final times will be posted in the regular bulletin. The lobby at the Best Western has more information once the convention starts.

YOUTH CLUB/CONVENTION

There will be a Youth Talent and God, Flag, and Country Contest held at the Convention on Friday afternoon 3:00-6:00 p.m. June 10th 2022.

RESOLUTIONS

Resolutions are to be sent to the State Secretary by May 10th, 2022. These must be passed by an Aerie and signed by the Local Aerie Secretary and Worthy President. Be sure your seal is also on the Resolution.

MICHIGAN STATE EAGLES CONVENTION, DISTRICT AND AERIE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR TALENT CONTEST!

A statewide Talent Contest will be conducted. Starting on a local Aerie level, the semifinal shall be conducted on a District level, comprised of the Local Aerie winners of that District.

The finals shall be conducted at the State Convention. Only District winners shall be eligible to compete in the State Finals.

There can be up to three State winners:

1. A male winner.
2. A female winner.
3. A group winner.
4. Overall State winner will be selected from the three category winners.

Each Aerie and each District may select up to **THREE WINNERS** from the **THREE GROUPS** to represent their Aerie or District to compete at the State level (i.e. only one winner from each group male, female, and group winners can complete).

An Aerie or District may have **more than one contestant** at the District or State level.

Only District winners shall be eligible to compete in the State Finals.

1. All contestants must register for their local Aerie contest no later than _____ (date at the Aerie's option). All Aerie Secretaries must certify their contest winners to the District Chairman no later than _____ (date at the district's option).

2. A registration form must be filled out by the contestant and signed.
3. A contestant must be a member of the Aerie or Auxiliary.
4. A contestant must be at least (18) years of age at the time of the local Aerie contest. No person under the age of (18) years of age shall in any way be involved in assisting in the contest.
5. The President of each Aerie shall appoint a Committee to expedite their local contest and shall also select at least three, no more than five, individuals, from the Aerie or Auxiliary or a combination of both, to serve as Judges of the Local Contest. The decision of the Judges shall be final and binding.
6. The Chairman from each District shall also comply with rule #5.
7. Each District shall conduct a Semi-Final Contest, of the winners from each Aerie in their respective District, no later than the May District meeting.
8. Each Aerie or District may select an Alternate, who may serve in the place of the winner, should he, she or they be unable to continue competition.
9. Dress for the Aerie, District and State Contests shall be up to the contestant as long as it is discreet.
10. The expenses of the Aerie and District winners shall be the responsibility of the sponsoring Aerie or District.
11. Any gifts, awards, etc. shall be determined by the local Aerie, District, or State.
12. Each District Chairman shall certify their winner to the State Secretary no later than June 1st of the State Contest year.

13. Judging of contestants, at every level of the contest, shall be based upon PERSONALITY AND TALENT. [The judging is based on a total of (100) points: (25) points for personality and (75) points for talent.
14. At each level of the contest, the contestant may, if he, she or they so desire, have a few minutes to sing, talk or perform some act that may aid the Judges in determining a winner.
15. There will be **NOTIES**. If the Judges provide a tie vote for the winner of a contest, they shall reconvene and select a winner from the contestants that have the tied vote.
16. The Judges, at the State level, will be selected from Past State Presidents.
17. All contestants for the State Finals **MUST** meet with the State Chairman at 12:00 (noon) on the day of the State Competition, at the Men's Headquarters.
18. Each contestant, at the State Competition, must furnish all or any equipment needed for his, her or their talent competition, such as CD's, flash drives, records, props, etc., and someone to operate them. A house PA system will be provided. Please Note that monitors are not allowed for use in competition at the Local, District, or State level competition.
19. Past Overall State Competition winners are allowed to compete again if they do so in the duet/group category.

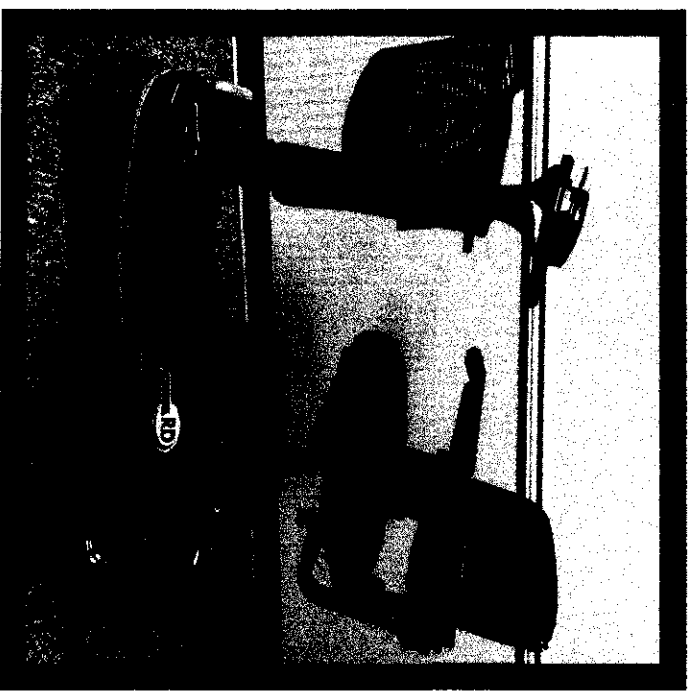
